## 2024 Alan Barham Maintenance Award

### The Alan Barham Maintenance Award is open to submissions from Australian Rail Track Corporation, UGL Regional Linx, Sydney Trains and other large-scale RIM's

### What is a Maintenance Team?

A typical Routine Maintenance team undertakes surveillance inspections, servicing, minor corrective maintenance, and emergency response, for track, bridges, right of way assets, and possibly signal assets.

### How will it be judged?

A panel of PWI members will complete the judging.

Submission documentation, site visits, reference checks and any other relevant sources of information will all be used in the judge's review. The team also needs to be operating in NSW.

### What are the judging criteria?

The period under consideration is 1 October 2023 to 30 September 2024. Nominating teams will be assessed against specific criteria and the judges will evaluate outcomes which are within the Maintenance Team's control as far as possible. It is recognised that track configuration, investment programs and operating parameters are often outside the Maintenance Team's control.
